Short title.

INTERNATIONAL BANKING (ENFORCEMENT OF ORDERS) REGULATIONS, 2006.

2. (1) Where the Central Bank has issued any order, directive, circular or regulations pursuant to the provisions of the International Banking Act, and any person refuses, neglects or otherwise fails to comply therewith, the Central Bank may, without prejudice to any other remedy available to it under the said Act or any other law, apply summarily to the Supreme Court for such Orders of the Court as may be necessary for enforcing such order, directive, circular or regulation.

Enforcement of orders, directives, etc., of Central Bank CAP. 267.

 Without limiting the generality of subregulation
above, such Order of the Court may include an Order conferring on the Registrar of the Court authority to do any act or take any step necessary to secure compliance with such order, directive, circular or regulation.
